## January Recipe

### Ham & Cheese Sliders

#### Ingredients

- 1 lb Deli ham
- 2 garlic cloves
- 1 tsp Parsley, fresh
- 1 tsp Worcestershire sauce
- 1 Pinch salt & pepper
- 1 12 count package Hawaiian rolls
- 1/2 cup Butter
- 6 slices Mozzarella cheese
- 6 slices Provolone cheese



#### Directions

##### Step 1

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Spray an 11 inch baking dish with nonstick cooking spray. Slice a loaf of King's Hawaiian Rolls across the middle to form two slabs. Keep the rolls connected and place a hand firmly on top of the rolls to make it easier to cut. Remove the top half and load up the bottom half with the fillings.

##### Step 2

Layer fillings. Provolone first, lots of sliced ham, and then mozzarella cheese.

##### Step 3

Replace the top half of the rolls and make the garlic butter with melted butter, minced garlic, fresh chopped parsley, and worcestershire sauce. Brush the mixture on the tops of the rolls.

##### Step 4

Stick toothpicks in the tops of the rolls and then cover with foil. Bake the rolls for 15 minutes or until golden brown. Cool Slightly then cut the sliders apart.
